Expression of Interest

The NZSS campaign is being run as a domestic event, where they will be involved in an Invitational Quad tournament, Auckland from the $24^{th} - 27^{th}$ October (Labour Weekend).

The focus of the 4 day campaign is the continued learning around the Key Coaching Priorities – Athlete Habits, Transitioning to Different Environments, Intensity of Training, Fundamental Skill Sets. As well as providing the opportunity for some of the top secondary school players in New Zealand, to play with and against each other.

Event Details

In September, 24 secondary school players will be chosen for the NZSS squad. The NZSS Management Team will remotely monitor these players leading up to the event in October. The squad will gather for skills sessions and trial matches on Friday, October 24th. That evening, selections for the NZSS Team and the NZSS A Invitational Team will be made. Following the selections, the respective management teams will take over, conducting team meetings, training sessions, and match play for the remainder of the weekend.

Netball New Zealand are seeking a Head Coach and Assistant Coach to lead the NZSS A Invitational Team. Given the short duration of the event, we require adaptable coaches who can quickly engage with the challenge and align with the Key Coaching Priorities. The preferred candidate(s) will have extensive coaching experience, particular with secondary school level players within the sport of Netball.
