The Coach will be required to plan and deliver an U21 World Cup Campaign with the support of the Pathways Program Manager and NNZ High Performance Team The purpose of this plan will be creating a performance environment and winning culture for the U21s 2025 World Youth Cup Campaign, which ultimately will contribute to producing Silver Ferns who inspire the nation.

Working as part of the NNZ High Performance team, you will work with system coaches to support the player development of nationally identified players and coach the U21 Squad and U21 Team.
